Georgia has received credit from the World Bank toward the cost of the Third Regional Development Project (RDP III) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The Municipal Development Fund of Georgia (hereinafter the employer) is a legal entity of public law whose purpose is to mobilize financial resources from donors including international and Georgian financial institutions, in order to make them available for investments in local infrastructure and services, while simultaneously helping local self-governments in strengthening their institutional and financial capacity. MDF programs envisage implementation of various projects including the Third Regional Development Project financed by the World Bank Group and the Georgian Government (GoG).

The Consulting Services under captioned assignment ("the Services") include the "Preparation of Detailed Design Documentation for Arrangement of Tourist Infrastructure and Urgent Restoration Works for Zarzma Monastery".

The aim of the project is to promote tourism development in Meskheta and Samtskhe-Javakheti Regions, including the arrangement of tourist infrastructure at the cultural heritage monuments' adjacent areas. Namely, preparation of Detailed Design Documentation for Arrangement of Tourist Infrastructure and Urgent Restoration Works for Zarzma Monastery.

The tentative duration of the assignment is 140 days.

The Municipal Development Fund of Georgia (MDF) as an Implementing Agency now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to express their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information/evidences demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. Expression of interest should cover, but not limited to: corporate profile, years in business, experience relevant to the project activities, key staff resources, and core business.

The shortlisting criteria are:

1. From January 1st, 2012 till the deadline for submission of the expressions of interests, the Consultant shall have experience in preparation of cultural heritage sites restoration/rehabilitation designs in at least two contracts, that has been completed within the last five years and that is similar to the proposed consultant services by physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods and technology. Rating shall be made on a combination of the value and the number of the relevant consultancy contracts. Weighted score for evaluation is 80.

2. Local experience of design preparation. Rating shall be made on a combination of the value and the number of the relevant consultancy/design contracts. Weighted score for evaluation is 20.

The positive recommendation letter from the National Agency of Cultural Heritage Protection (NACHP), or the Center of Architecture, Art and Restoration of the Patriarchate of Georgia will be an asset.

Note: the MDF reserves it's right to verify submitted references and use obtained information for evaluation purposes.

Consultants may associate with other firms (Please take into account that form of association acceptable for the World Bank is either sub-consultancy or Joint-Venture and submission must clearly indicate the nature of the association. The experience of sub-consultants will not be taken into account while evaluating the corporate experience of the consultant).
